

4 Spotter Guides

SAND DUNES



Marram grass

With tough grey-green leaves, this plant helps to stabilise sand dunes.



Sea bindweed

This pretty flower will be found growing on dunes, often partly covered in sand.



Silverweed

This creeping plant has feathery silver or green leaves.



Restharrow

A pretty flower with strong creeping roots.



Lady's bedstraw

The sweet scent of this flower means it was once used to make bedrooms smell nice.



Field grasshopper

This grasshopper loves warm sunny spots on the coast.



Six-spot burnet moth

Six red spots make this day flying moth easy to see.

Silver Y moth

Arriving from far away this day flying moth has distinctive white 'Y' wing markings.



White/brown lipped snail

Yellow or yellow with brown bands – look at the colour of the shell lip, is it brown or white?
