

# 1 Spotter Guides

## ROCKY SHORES



**Common limpet**

Look for these seashells clinging on to rocks on the upper shore.



**Sea slater**

Related to the woodlouse, sea slaters will be found under stones on the upper shore.



**Sea ivory**

This lichen grows on rocks making them look like they are covered in grey hair.



**Cormorant**

Often seen on rocks with their wings outstretched as they dry their feathers in the sunshine.



**Oystercatcher**

With orange bill and pink legs this bird makes a distinctive piping call.



**Bladder wrack**

This seaweed has lots of bladders, so it floats capturing sunlight when the tide comes in.



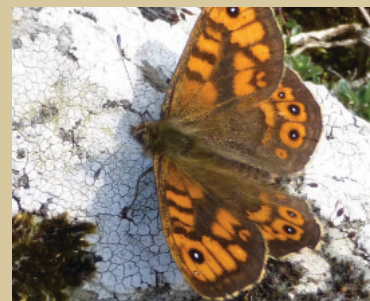
**English stonecrop**

The tiny egg-shaped leaves change from grey-green to red.



**Thrift**

With flowers like pink pom-poms on cushions of grass-like leaves.



**Wall butterfly**

This butterfly likes to bask in the sunshine on rocks or walls.



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
